

Candidate Filing – Residency Documents

Candidates must provide proof of residence when filing for office.

Bring an unexpired ID from this list that has your current name and address:

- Valid Minnesota driver's license, learner's permit, or Minnesota ID card.
- Tribal ID with name, address, signature, and photo.

Or bring an approved photo ID and an approved document that has your current name and address:

Approved photo IDs (can be expired):

- Driver's license, state ID, or learner's permit issued by any state
- United States passport
- United States Military or Veteran ID
- Tribal ID with name, signature, and photo
- Minnesota university, college, or technical college ID
- Minnesota high school ID

Approved documents (must contain current address):

- Residential lease or rental agreement valid through election day
- Current student fee statement
- Bill, account, or start of service statement due or dated within 30 days of the beginning of the candidate filing period:
 - Phone, TV, or internet
 - Solid waste, sewer, electric, gas, or water
 - Banking or credit card
 - Rent or mortgage
